ST MATTHEW'S CHANCEL



The PCC's proposal to make the chancel more useful and comfortable for smaller services, and for overspill seating, has now been considered by the Diocesan Committee for the Care of Churches (DAC). They have supported the proposal to remove the south and north facing choir stalls and replace them with 12 Treske St. Wilfrid's armchairs and 6 side chairs. The next step towards formal approval from the Diocese is the display of Public Notices for 28 days. These are now up in the church and porch, together with a copy of the plans.
