

Rev Hassan and Rev Kuwa are pastors of their local church and senior leaders of the Sudan Church of Christ. Rev Hassan tried to help his friend, Abdulmonem, raise money to treat a badly burned young man – a man who had taken part in a student protest.

For this act of kindness they could soon be on death row, along with Rev Kuwa, whose only 'crime' is being Rev Hassan's friend and a Christian leader.

They face at least seven charges, including two that carry the death penalty. They've done nothing wrong. We must push for their unconditional release.


