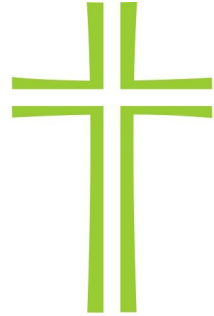

KIDS CHURCH

Special recognition should go to Joseph who managed to memorise them in full, not just the summary version that so many of us might know! The 5 of them will be enjoying a special trip out for their reward. How many of the commandments could you recite? God's grace & mercy mean so little to so many people because they have no sense of His standards of holiness and righteousness.

TREASURE IN HEAVEN

This term the Kids Church children voted to donate their "Cheerful Givers" collection to a campaign to help the persecuted Christians in Mosul. Mosul is in the ancient plain of Ninevah - the city that was converted by Jonah, and is one of the most ancient Christian communities in the world. I'm sure it was no coincidence that we'd just listened to the historical events of Jonah in Kids Church the week before. Sadly the amount that has been given in Kid's Church this term has been much lower than normal - only £7 compared to the usual amounts of £20-£30. We teach the children to see giving as part of our weekly worship, so if you or they have got out of the habit maybe this is good opportunity to be reminded of it. ³¹ Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

³² And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down.³³ Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."
