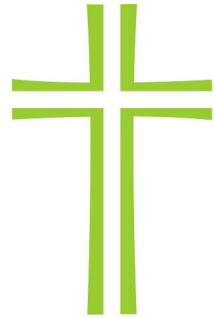

Sarah know.

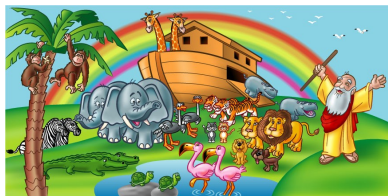
