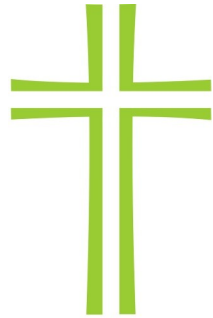

LUKE

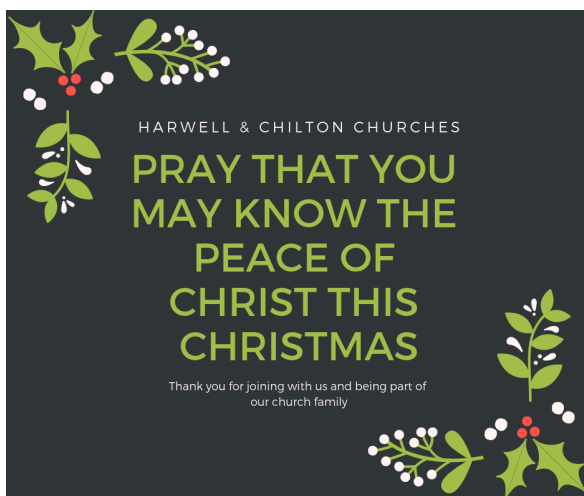

We are so thankful to each one of you who serve in our churches - many behind the scenes. We are truly grateful and couldn't operate without you!

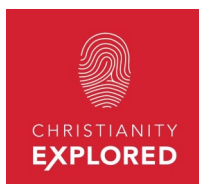
