

## HOLY WEEK



If you don't have one of our Easter cards - please pick one up today, or see our website for details of our Easter services.

We would love to welcome you along to our services during Holy Week - the lead up to Easter Sunday.

We would encourage as many as possible to join in with the full range of Easter Services. We cannot be Easter people if we are not first Good Friday and Holy Saturday people!

#### Maundy Thursday

This celebration of Holy Communion links back to the Last Supper of our Lord at which he washes he disciples' feet as a graphic illustration of what he is about to do for them. It leads into the Garden of Gethsemane, his arrest and trial.

#### **Good Friday Service**

Join with us to share the silence that is a significant part of this reflective service. Come and stand by the wood of the cross on which our Saviour hung and died. It is not a day for many words. Better to give a little time for quiet reflection.

#### Holy Saturday Vigil

Come and share with us 'Light in the Dark'; it's a time for candlelight and readings. The light for the Easter Candle is taken from a newly kindled fire and we will all stand around it at the beginning of the service. It's both a time of silence and a time of great rejoicing and singing as Easter is announced.

It's a time to follow The Easter Acclamation with bells and music. Holy Saturday Evening gives us a particular kind of space if we are prepared to take it, amidst what is often a busy weekend.

#### Easter Sunday

On this most joyful of days, we celebrate our Lord's victory over sin and death with a service of Holy Communion for the whole church family, and always have a good number of visitors. Celebrate the most joyful day of the Church calendar.
