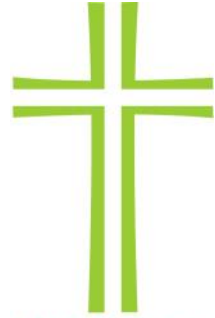


Welcome

EVERGREENS

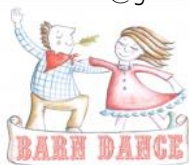
