tinned veg

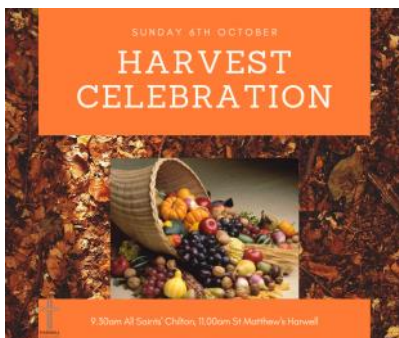
long life juice
