PLAQUE SCHEME SUMMARY

The plaque is made of cast bronze, six inches by four inches in size and fixed onto a twelve inch stem which is placed in the ground.

It is cast with embossed (raised) lettering. Up to 60 characters including punctuation are permitted. The wording is subject to final approval by the PCC.

(It would be possible to add further letters at a later date, providing space is planned for this and that the maximum of 60 characters is not exceeded)

The plaque is ordered through the PCC and is of a standardised type, cast by Arkell and Hurcombe.

Please allow six weeks for delivery.

- It is to be placed in the planted area surrounding the Garden of Remembrance and not in the lawn itself.
- Although the plaque is attractive in its own right the family may wish to plant a small shrub (or bulbs) which should not exceed two feet when fully grown.
- Any vase of cut flowers should be placed behind the plaque and any temporary markers will be removed after a period of six months.

The plaque is the purchaser's property. The incumbent, PCC, and churchwardens cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage.

PLEASE NOTE: In addition to the cost of the plaque there are statutory fees payable to the Diocese and PCC. Will you therefore please enclose two separate payments when returning your completed order form?
